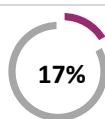

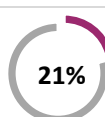
Really tasty, spicy flavour, great quality, very fresh

Looked good tasted great with just the right level of spicy kick



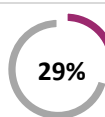
Fresh and spicy with a strong kick
